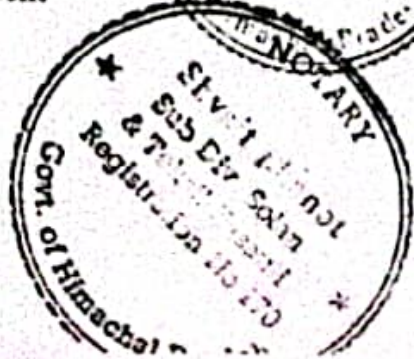

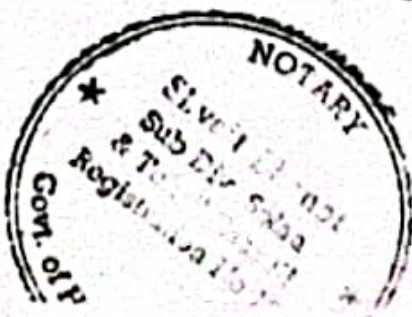

RULES & REGULATIONS/ BYE LAWS OF HIMACHAL PRADESH STATE CHESS ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE-1.

Name of the Association

The name of the Association is:

Himachal Pradesh State Chess Association
Abbreviated as "HPSCA"

ARTICLE-2.

HEAD OFFICE:-

The Head office of the Association shall remain in Dist Shimla and presently it is at the following address:-

ARTICLE-3.

Article operation :-

The area of operation of the association shall be chess throughout

Himachal Pradesh.

ARTICLE-4.

TENURE OF THE EXECUTIVE BODY:-

Office bearers and members of the Executive Body of the Association shall hold the office as such for one or more terms of four years each on obtaining simple majority votes of the Members present and voting the Elections.

12. To ensure the full participation of youth in National Construction.
13. To develop the leadership qualities in the Youths.
14. To make mass awareness regarding the sports, Traditional Chess and health.
15. To organize the State Level Tournaments/Championship Nationals levels for Sub-Juniors, Juniors and Seniors every year for the promotion of the sports of Chess Nationals levels.
16. To organize/hosts and State level Tournaments/Championships,Demonstrations,camps etc for the promotion of the sports of Chess.
17. To represent State Association in AICF meetings and Championships.
18. To honors the outstanding sportspersons with Certificate and Cash Awards.
19. To provide better coaching facilities and sports equipments to the Outstanding Chess players.
20. To introduce the Arbiter and Scorer in the Chess Competitions in accordance with the rules of Chess under the supervision of AICF.
21. To take disciplinary action against all those members which/who do not conform to the Byelaws and guidelines of the Association in original or amended form from time to time.

ARTICLE:7(1)

PRIMARY SPORTS BODIES/CLUBS MEMBERS

A. Definition of the Primary Sports Bodies/Club Members:

The Primary Sports Body member means a Sports Unit/Club of Chess working at Sub-Division or Tehsil or City or Village level and is constituted by the individuals and is affiliated to the District Chess Association affiliated with State Association.

B. Qualification Criteria for the Primary Sports Bodies/Club Members:

Any Chess organization representing a village, city Tehsil or sub-division of the District is eligible for membership if it fulfills all the following criteria:

- i. If its representatives submit the written application to the President/General Secretary of the Association.
- ii. If the application is approved by the 2/3rd majority of the Executive body of the Association.
- iii. If it submits the specified fees mentioned in the byclaws of the Association.
- iv. If it submits its Memorandum and Bye-Laws to the Association.
- v. If its objectives are similar to those of the Association and for the promotion of Chess.
- vi. If it agrees in writing to be bound by the memorandum and Bye-laws of the Association.
- vii. If it agrees to include/expel any person/club/organization in /from it on the directions of the Association.
- viii. If it agrees to conduct the tournaments and all other activities under the guidelines and supervision of the Association.
- ix. If it agrees to furnish every year detail progress report of its activities and a roster of its members.
- x. If it agrees to call an observer on the Elections of the Executive Body from the State Association.

ARTICLE 7(3):-

NOMINATED MEMBERS:

A. Definition of the Nominated Members:
The Executive Body of the Association shall nominate the persons for the following nominated posts of the Association for a period no exceeding one year at a time. (The above period can be further extendable for duration of one year keeping in view the past performance).

Executive Body may fill these nominated posts either from the Members of General Body or from the Professional outside.

The Executive Body of the Association has the right to change any of the Nominated Members provided there shall be 2/3rd majority for the decision.

This category of the members may include:

- i) Patron in Chief.
- ii) Chairman.
- iii) Vice Chairman
- iv) Chief Advisor.
- v) Technical Director etc.
- vi) Working President.



ARTICLE 8.

DISQUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS;

A member shall be disqualified from the membership:

- a. If s/ he is defaulter to the Association.
- b. If s/ he ceases to have any of the qualification for membership prescribed in Bye-laws.
- c. If s/he has been expelled by a resolution passed by 2/3rd Majority of the members entitled to vote from among those who are present at a General Meeting.

- d. If s/he is persistent defaulter. But, before expelling a member s/he shall be given an opportunity to present his case before the General Body that shall decide the issue.
- e. If s/he is working against any of the objectives of the Association.
- f. A member of the General Body Association or the Executive Body shall cease to be such membership if he;

- i. Dies, or
- ii. Resigns, or
- iii. Becomes of unsound mind, or
- iv. Is convicted of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude, or
- v. Is removed by the Executive Body with the consent of 2/3rd majority of members by passing requisite resolution in the meeting of General Body.
- vi. Fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the Association of the General/Executive Body without the written leave, or
- vii. Has not paid subscription fee for a period exceeding two month after the due date.

ARTICLE 8.1:

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE MEMBERS:

No person shall be a member unless:

- a. Has completed 18(Eighteen) years of age.
- b. He must have good Educational cum Technical Qualifications (preference for membership shall be given to those persons having higher Educational cum Technical qualification).
- c. Has submitted the written application in the prescribed form for membership and has been recommended by majority of the Executive Body and approved by the General Body.
- d. A member shall be a person who has:
 - i. Admitted to the Association according to its Rules and Regulations, and
 - ii. Paid subscription provided in the Rules, and
 - iii. Signed the roll or list of members of the Association, and
 - iv. No resigned in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Association.
 - v. No criminally convicted for moral turpitude.
 - vi. Not an addicted and bankrupt.

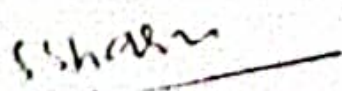

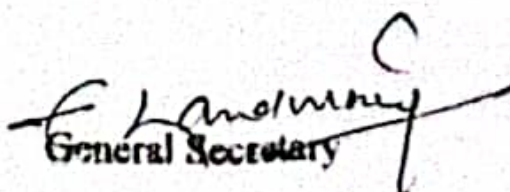

ARTICLE 10.1(A)**RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE PSB/CLUBS MEMBERS.**

The Primary Sports Bodies/Clubs Members of the Association shall have the following rights and privileges.

- I. President/Gen Secretary or two representatives (Nominated by the Executive Body) of each Dist.Sports Body/Club of Chess shall be the member of the General Body of the Association.
- II. All the member of the Executive Body of the Dist.Chess Association/Club are eligible for contesting the Elections for any of the post of the Executive Body of the Association. However, a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding two months shall not be so entitled.
- III. Each Primary Sports Body/Club is entitled to receive notice of all the Annual and Special General Meetings at their addresses with the Association. However a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding two months shall not be so entitled.
- IV. President/Gen.Secy. or two representative(Nominated by the Executive Body) of each Dist.Sports Body/Club of Chess is entitled to vote in all the Annual, Special General Meetings of the Association. However, a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding two months shall not be so entitled.

ARTICLE 10.1 (B):

RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS:

The individual members of the Association shall have the following rights and privileges:

- i. Individual Members shall be the members of the General Body of the Association.
- ii. Individual Members are entitled to receive notice of all the Annual & Special General Meetings at their addresses with the Association.
- iii. Individual Members shall have the right to attend the General Body Meetings of the Association with the power to vote except for the General House for the purpose of the Elections of the Executive Body of the Association. However, a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding two months shall not be so entitled.
- iv. Individual Members shall be provided a membership Certificate duly signed by the General Secretary and the President of the Association.

ARTICLE 10.1 (C):

RIGHTS & PRIVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS NOMINATED MEMBERS

Nominated Members of the Association shall have the following rights and privileges:

- i. Nominated Members shall be the members of the General Body of the Association.
- ii. Nominated Members are entitled to receive notice of all the annual and special general meetings at their addresses with the Association. However, a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding three months shall not be so entitled.
- iii. Nominated members will have the right to attend all the General Body Meetings of the Association with the power to vote except in the General House for the purpose of the Elections of the Executive Body of the Association. However, a member that is in arrears of his/her subscription for a period exceeding two months shall not be so entitled.
- iv. Nominated members shall be provided a membership Certificate duly signed by General Secretary and the President of the Association.

ARTICLE 11:

RESIGNATION, EXPULSION OF MEMBERS/OFFICE BEARER.

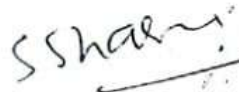
The General Body shall have the power to elect a new member in place of removed official, provided that where new official is elected he/she shall work only for the unexpired term of the Executive Body.

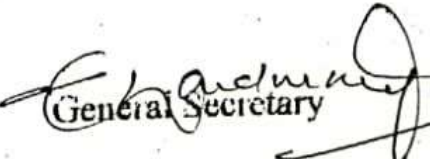

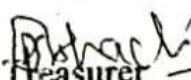
CONSTITUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE BODY OF THE ASSOCIATION.

The President Executive Body of the Association is as recorded in the proceeding of the Association at Resolution No.24.6.06 passed by the General House for the purpose of the elections of the Executive Body in the Presence of the observer appointed by the Haryana Pradesh Youth sports and services deptt.

The term of this body shall be for four years only. Simple majority shall elect the subsequent Executive Bodies after the expiry of the tenure of the present and subsequent Executive Bodies. The Executive Body of the Association can have a minimum members of Eleven and maximum of twenty-one member as per the direction laid down in the H. P. Sports Act, 2005. hence the present number can further be increased in any valid Executive Body meeting with the consent of General Body.

III. Rights and Privileges of the Executive Body Members:

- i. All the Executive Body Members are entitled to receive notice of all the annual and special general meeting of the Executive Body and General Body at their addresses with the Association. However, a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding three months shall not be so entitled.
- ii. Executive Body Members are entitled to vote in all the annual and special general meetings of the Executive Body & General Body except for the General House for the purpose of the Elections of the Executive Body of the Association. However, a member who is in arrears of his subscription for a period exceeding three months shall not be so entitled.
- iii. Executive Body Members shall be provided a Membership Certificate duly signed by the President, General Secretary and H.P. State Chess Association which shall be subject to renewal every year.

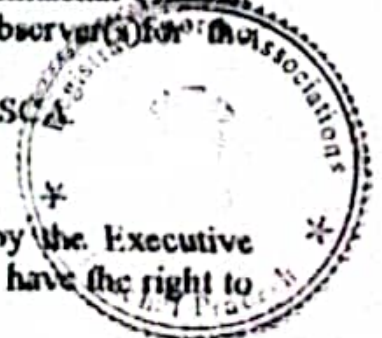

ARTICLE 13:
ELECTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE BODY.

A. Mode of Elections of The Executive Body of the Association:

- i. The Executive Body of the Association shall be elected in democratic manner by holding the periodical Elections.
- ii. The Elections, of the Association shall be held in accordance with the Byelaws of the Association, in the AGM for the purpose of the Elections of the Executive Body, Elections shall always be the last agenda.
- iii. The Elections for the Executive Body shall be held at least once in every four years in the General House for the purpose of Elections of the Executive Body of the Association or during the State level championship.
- iv. The Executive Body of the Association shall decide the venue of the Elections.
- v. An Independent Elections Officer in the presence of the Elections observer(s) shall conduct the Elections of the Association.
- vi. The General House/president of the Association would appoint an Elections Officer.
- vii. The Himachal Pradesh State Chess Association/H.P. Sports Council shall appoint the observer(s) for the Elections.

No. District Chess Association/Club will accredit an individual as representative to attend a Himachal Pradesh State Chess Association Annual General or Extraordinary general Assembly meeting unless he is a regular member of their Association. The notification shall also specify the time schedule for the withdrawal of the nominations, scrutiny of the nominations and Election.

During the District level, State level, State Olympic level or any other competition any unsportsmanlike behaviour on the part of a sportsman, sportswoman, official or coach, which include insulting, making undesirable gestures, abusing the decision of the Judges/Referee, Athletes and provoking the opponent or spectators etc. in a word, committing any act not in keeping with the propriety of sports, shall be punished as follows:

In the event of disagreement concerning the above Disciplinary rules, the interpretation of these regulations shall fall under the competence of HPSCA Executive Body, which shall be the final authority.

ARTICLE 37.

DISAFFILIATION/DE-RECOGNIZATION/SUSPENSION OF MEMBERS UNITS;

The General Body of Chess Association of Himachal Pradesh, on the recommendation of President/ General Secretary, either directly or through the Executive Body, based on his direction, is entitled to consider disaffiliation/ de-reorganization / suspension of District Body members/HPSCA recognized state bodies on one or more of the under mentioned grounds after ensuring that show cause notice has been serviced.

- a. Non-observance of directives issued by the H.P. State Chess Association from time to time.
- b. Non holding the elections after the completion of the normal tenure for which the office bearers are elected. Any extension of the tenure of the office bearers will be subject to obtaining prior written permission from the Association.
- c. Not submitting annual statements of the account, annual report and list of current Executive Body and General Body members.
- d. If the member unit is working against any of the objectives of the Association.

ARTICLE 38.

MISCELLANEOUS

HIMACHAL PRADESH STATE CHESS ASSOCIATION will ensure that.

- a. Association must hold at least one competition each for Senior, Junior and Sub-Junior.
- b. The statutes, rules, regulations, byelaws, directions and instruction issued from the office of All India Chess Federation, shall guide the H.P. Association.
- c. The Association will affiliate only those Chess Associations at District level which are duly recognized by the Chess Association of Himachal Pradesh.

- d. It shall be binding on the affiliated units to forward their annual report and audited or approved statements of accounts every year. The affiliated units must conduct their Elections as and when due or in special circumstances as and when directed by the Association. However in the Elections held by all or any of the unit(s) to reconstitute its/their Executive Bodies or to elect new Office bearers, the date and time of the Elections shall be intimated to the Association and President and General Secretary shall nominate the Elections observer to attend the Elections meeting and who shall submit his/ her report to the President and General Secretary for appropriate action. The non-compliance of these requirements may result in disaffiliation of the defaulting unit units by the Association's General Body on the recommendations of the Executive Body.
- e. All the affiliated units will forward to the Association a copy of their current and valid constitution along with the amendments whenever made from time to time.
- f. Any appeal by the member of an affiliated Unit complaining against the procedure adopted by the concerned affiliated unit for holding Elections or any other issue connected with this subject must be in writing to the Association within 30 days of the occurrence of the incident. No complaint will be considered valid or entertained by the Association if it is made after the expiry of the 30 days period. The complaint must be specific and contain documentary evidence to prove the issue that is disputed.
